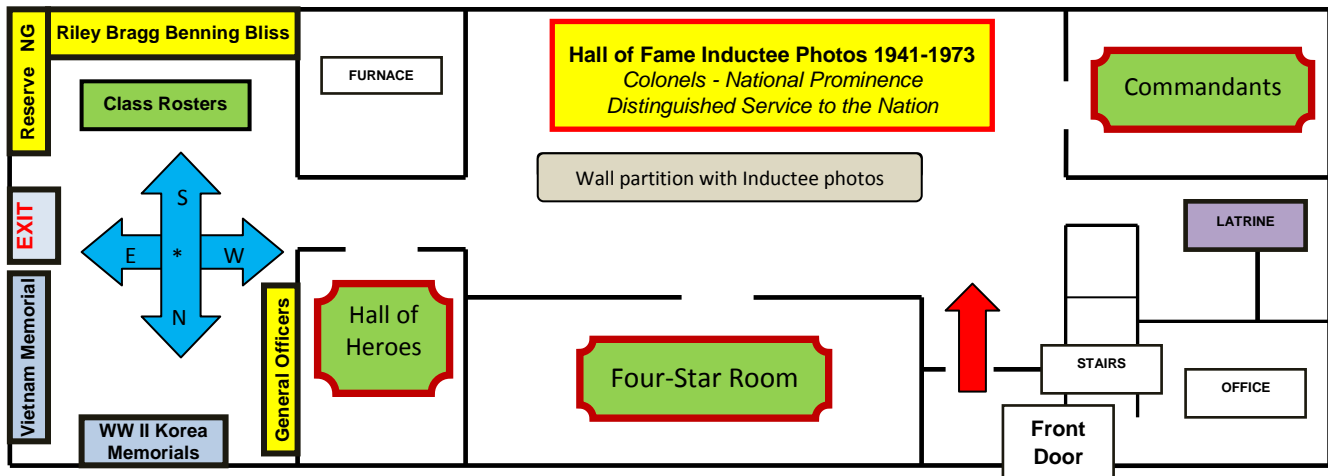


Durham Hall Ground Floor Map



Main Room

Inductee photographs (Colonel's, National Prominence, and Distinguished Service to the Nation) are mounted on the walls and on a center partition in the main hall. They are in class order starting on the north wall just past the guestbook area and wind around to end at the northwest corner of the room. Current year inductee photos are displayed near the entrance.

The Four-Star Room has display cases and memorabilia dedicated to GEN Jack Merritt, GEN John Shalkasvili, GEN Tommy Franks, GEN Kevin Byrnes and GEN Doug Brown.

The Hall of Heroes room honors the two Medal of Honor and 83 Distinguished Service Cross recipients.

The Commandants Room has photographs of FAOCS Commandants from 1941-1973 and the Commandants Trophy. A recognition wall honoring Anna Lou Johnson, former managing Director of the Field Artillery Association is located in the northeast corner of the room.

East Room

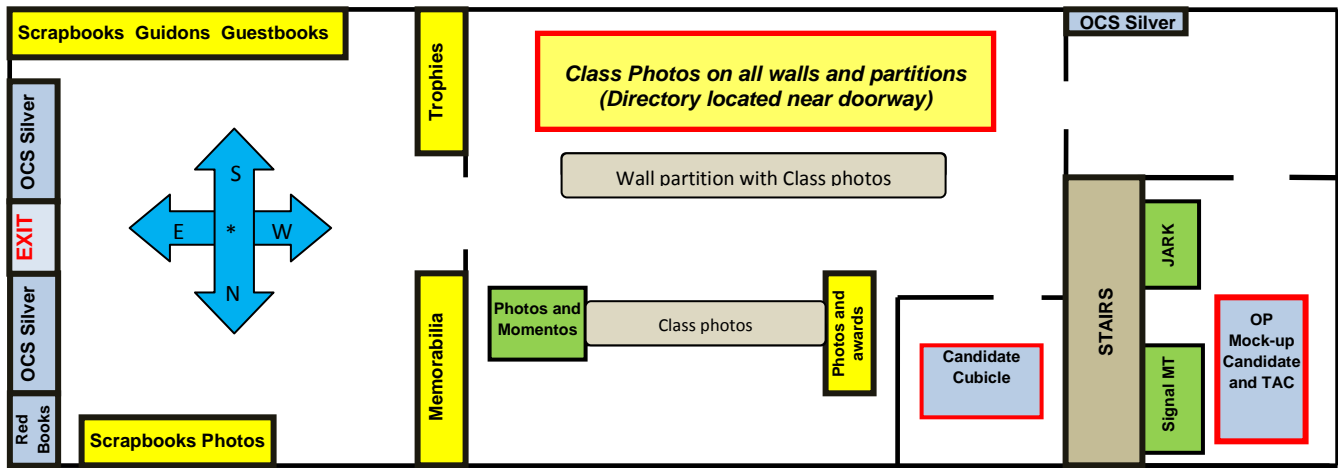
General Officer Inductees photographs are mounted on the west wall in class order. National Guard, Reserve, Fort Bliss, Fort Bragg, Fort Riley, Branch Immaterial (Fort Benning) and Honorary inductees are found in southeast corner.

Memorials to FAOCS graduates lost in World War II, Korea and Vietnam are prominently displayed along with a comprehensive set of companion reference materials with biographical information on the 1179 graduates killed in action.

Class Rosters for the 1940's, 50's, 60's, and 70's along with a Master Roster of Graduates (Alphabetical) are found on the large table. In addition a Master Roster of Hall of Fame Inductees is located on that table

A computer station with searchable databases and digital images of the OCS experience is available for your enjoyment.

A portion of the OCS Silver collection is on display in a case at the top of the stairs.

A mock-up of a candidate and TAC officer during an observed fire class and a General Jark display can be found in a separate room in the far northwest section of the upper level. MB4 can be viewed to the northwest by looking out a window on the north end of the room

Main room

Class photos are displayed on several walls and two partitions in the main room. A diagram of the locations is displayed on the easel at the entrance to the main room. Most of the classes from the 1950's, 1960's, and 1970's are available, however a limited number of photos from the 1940's have been obtained.

A candidate cubicle and many other mementos are found in a small room located in the northwest corner of the main room.

Various pieces of OCS memorabilia donated by graduates are on display throughout the upper level.

A large collection of photographs and news clippings can be found in scrapbooks and notebooks on the display cases.

East Room

Guidons from many of the classes are hanging in the east room and displayed in the pullout drawers of the display cases.

Class Redbooks from the 1950's can be found in the bookcase located in the northeast corner of the East Room.

A Candidate Wives Club scrapbook and Guest books from years past are located in the southeast corner of the room.

The main OCS Silver collection is located in two large display cases on the east wall.

Trophies awarded to candidates for outstanding academic and athletic achievements are on display throughout the room

A painting of a "Candidate" by COL Charles Howard (FAOCS graduate and OCS Commandant, 1966-1968) hangs on the north wall.
